Celebrating Small Business

October is small business month, with many great events, but if you are looking for a one on one discussion with someone about your business direction and challenges you might want to visit Community Futures North Fraser. Each year we provide advisory services to over 100 local businesses, and talking business with Community Futures can help you grow.

Statistics Canada tracks businesses supported by Community Futures and their numbers show CF-assisted firms outperformed a comparable group of non-assisted firms in employment growth, survival rate and revenue growth.

- CF-assisted firms had a survival rate of 76 percent five years after the start of their businesses compared to 60 percent for non-assisted firms
- CF-assisted firms had a revenue growth rate of 13.8 percent compared to 6.1 percent for non-assisted firms
- CF-assisted firms had an average employment growth rate of 9.5 percent compared to 4.2 percent for non-assisted firms
